Programme

- **Saturday 16th Oct 10** Scenic boat trips to Lords River, or Ulva Island, or "The Neck", BBQ Lunch included, visit local museum, Dinner and Great Social Evening.
- **Sunday 17th Oct 10 10.30am** the Trusts AGM.
- **Travel from island** by Ferry until Tuesday 19th October 2010 or make your own arrangements. By travelling later you can undertake some of the optional activities

Accommodation

You will be able to organise your accommodation through the Trust Office by coordinating with Nicola McLeod. We have organised listings of all accommodation available on the island so we can coordinate this directly with you. This way we will be able to monitor exactly what is still available as accommodation is progressively booked. You will be able to get full details with only one phone call to our office. If you have your own accommodation on the island simply let us know. The cost of your accommodation is not included in your registration and this will be your responsibility and subject to the terms and conditions of the individual suppliers. There is a full range of options from Backpackers, (right beside the venue), to luxury units and everything in between.

Other Activities

The official programme will take up most of the time available during the formal part of the weekend. Venue

All of the formal activities for the weekend will be held in the Community Centre and the two boat trips to Lords River and Ulva Island/The Neck will be on the Real Journey's Ferry's.

Registration

You need to complete the Registration Form included and return it with full payment as soon as possible to save your place on the trip. Nearly 200 people have registered their interest in this event and we can only cater for 160 people so you will need to be in very quick.

Positions will be allocated on a first come first serve basis so you will need to be very quick. The Registration covers all aspects of the weekend including ferry travel inside the dates offered. There will be no refunds or reduced cost if you can not take advantage of any aspect of the programme including if you choose not to use or don't need to use the ferry booking for any reason.
